Sermon Text References for July 11, 2021 2 Samuel 6:1-5, 12b-19 Psalm 24 (UMH 755) Ephesians 1:3-14 Mark 6:14-29

SCRIPTURE OVERVIEW: Two readings this week focus on welcoming God's presence. David does this by bringing the ark of the covenant into Jerusalem. As the ark arrives, David dances, worshiping God with reckless abandon. The author of Psalm 24 poetically calls a city to open its gates and welcome the great king. These passages invite us to consider how willingly we receive God into our lives. The reading from Ephesians speaks of God's eternal plan. While circumstances may seem chaotic, God holds an eternal perspective and has sealed us with the Holy Spirit. Mark tells the sad story of the execution of John the Baptist, yet another example of a righteous person experiencing persecution.



#### Testimony – Patsy Hoekstra

On June 27 I attended the Martin UMC and had the pleasure of hearing the message by Carolyn Buskirk. She spoke of "The Sower of Seeds". It was very meaningful and got me to thinking about who had sowed seeds in my life. As a child I grew up in a home where church wasn't offered except for VBS in the summer. I attended the Westwood UMC where Pastor Sean Kidd is now appointed. I had family in Mississippi where we went every summer and the highlight for me was attending the church where my uncle was the pastor of a Southern Baptist Pentecostal Church. I believe the seeds of love for God began there. In 2006, I had the opportunity to visit and thank them for being a strong influence in my life.

I have had another experience that led me to believe that there was something to having God in your life. My dear friends were in a car accident that killed him and left their newborn baby fatherless and his wife in the hospital with minor injuries. Now she was the oldest child in a catholic family of nine. I dreaded going to the hospital, what do I say to her? You can imagine my shock when I walked into her room with her sitting up in bed, laughing and chatting as if everything was normal. I will never forget her words, "It's ok, I will be with him again someday." I knew then that I needed to know more about God.

In 1994, I was invited to attend (a seed being planted) the Martin UMC and the rest is history!
