John 8:47 - "Whoever belongs to God hears what God says. The reason you do not hear is that you do not belong to God." This verse is part of a larger conversation between Jesus and the religious leaders of his time.


The United Methodist Church Human Relations Day Special Offering – May 21 2024

Souper Bowl of Caring February 11, 2024
