Lent is Coming....

Have you been thinking about Lent? Thinking about Easter? I know that we just finished our Christmas season, but time marches on and we are soon entering the season of Lent.

I hope that you will all plan to come and be part of our Ash Wednesday service at Shelbyville on February 22nd at 7:00 p.m.

Why do we receive ashes on Ash Wednesday? By wearing ashes we show repentance as well as showing devotion to God.

During the observance, ashes are placed on the worshiper's forehead, in the shape of a cross. The display of ashes reveals the recipient's belief in Jesus Christ and shows grief and mourning for our sins.

What are some Lenten practices?

These are known as the three pillars of Lent:

- prayer (justice towards God)
- fasting (justice towards self)
- almsgiving (justice towards neighbors)

During Lent, many people decide to give something up that they love - perhaps chocolate, sweets or even using social media. Others might decide to take *up* something, like helping out at a soup kitchen or working with the homeless or making an effort to help others that are in need.

We do these things during Lent as a sign of sacrifice or to test our self-discipline.

Whatever you do during Lent this year, I hope you will stay focused on increasing your relationship with our Heavenly Father...


