We are excited to launch the annual Peanut Butter Drive for the Allegan County Food Pantry Collaborative (ACFPC). The drive will kick-off on National Peanut Butter Day January 24th!

Our goal is to collect 5,000 jars of Peanut Butter to distribute amongst participating ACFPC members and families in need. By donating online or at one of the physical drop sites around the county, you are directly impacting a neighbor in need.

Your past support has made a significant impact in our communities. Due to your past support – in 2022 we were able to procure more than 10,000 cans of soup, nearly 4,000 jars of peanut butter, 8631 boxes of cereal and 1,728 pounds of ground beef for the ACFPC pantry members. Peanut Butter can be dropped off at the Martin UMC and the Shelbyville UMC!


