Sermon Text References for July 4, 2021 2 Samuel 5:1-5 and 9-10 Psalm 48 2 Corinthians 12:2-10 Mark 6:1-13

SCRIPTURE OVERVIEW: The readings from the Hebrew scriptures this week celebrate Jerusalem, the capital of the great King David, who united the ancient Israelites and built up the city. The psalmist praises Jerusalem using the image of Zion—a name used for earthly Jerusalem but also a gesture toward a future day when God's people will abide in a heavenly city. In Second Corinthians, Paul explains that even though he is an apostle, he struggles like everyone else. Speculation surrounds the "thorn" that plagued Paul; but his point is that when he is weakest, God is strongest. In Mark, we see God's power working through Jesus, who sent out others to expand God's healing work.


